Suggested new understanding of Psalms 64:2-3

We read in the Book of Psalms:

נעויתי שחתי עד-מאד; כל-היום קדר הלכתי.


"I am bent and was <u>lowered down</u> greatly; I go mourning all the day" (Ps 38:7; see also: Is 2:9, 11, 17; 5:15; 25:12; 60:14; Ps 10:10; 107:39).

אמר-ליהוה, מחסי ומצודתי; אלהי, אבטח-בו. כי הוא <u>יצילך מפח</u>יקוש;

"I will say of YHWH, who is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust; That He will rescue you from the snare of the fowler" (Ps 91:2-3).

Yet we also find in this book: שמע-אלהים קולי בשיחי; מפחד אויב תצר חיי - "Hear my voice, O God, in my complaint; preserve my life from the fear of the enemy" (Ps 64:2).

However, the comparison between these verses suggests the here בשיחי is a vowel letter exchange error of ישוחי - "when I am being lowered down." The comparison between these verses also suggests that מפחד אויב תצר חיי is a bilabial (th) - 7 (d), and a ל (l) - 7 (r) letter-substitution error of מפחד אויב תצל חיי of enemy snare You rescue my life."



In the Book of Job we read:

ישם בסד רגלי

"He put my feet in [the] stocks" (Job 33:11; see also: Job 13:27).

In the Book of Isaiah we read:

פתח חרצבות רשע, <u>התר</u> אגדות מוטה; ושלח רצוצים חפשים, "to open the fetters of wickedness, <u>to untie</u> the bands of the yoke, and to let the oppressed go free" (Is 58:6).

In the Book of Psalms we read:

כי-סלעי ומצודתי אתה; ולמען שמך תנחני ותנהלני. תוציאני-מ<u>רשת</u> זו טמנו לי:

"For You are my rock and my fortress; therefore, for Your name's sake lead me and guide me.

Bring me out of this <u>net</u> that they have hidden for me" (Ps 31:4-5).

Yet we also find in this book: תסתירני מסוד מרעים; מרגשת פעלי און - "<u>Hide me from the council of evil-doers; from the tumult</u> of the workers of iniquity" (Ps 64:3).

However, the comparison between these verses suggests that מ<u>ס</u>תירני מסוַד מרעים; is a letter-insertion error of : תתירני מסד מרעים: "You will <u>untie</u> me from the <u>stocks</u> of evil-doers."

The logic of this verse (and verse Ps 31:5) also suggests that מרגשת פעלי און is a letter-insertion error of: מרשת פעלי און - "from <u>the net</u> of the workers of iniquity."

In summary, we should read these verses as:

שמע-אלהים קולי בשוחי; מפחת אויב תצל חיי. תתירני מסד מרעים; מרשת פעלי און.

"Hear my voice, O God, when I am being lowered down; of the enemy's snare You will rescue my life;

You will <u>untie</u> me from the <u>stocks</u> of evil-doers; from <u>the net</u> of the workers of iniquity" (Ps 64:2-3).
